

DRY HEAT TREATMENT

This heating pad comes assembled (Figure 4).

This appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). As a safety feature, this plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature. This heating pad is intended for household use only and it is designed to operate at 110-125 Volts AC. Use on Alternating Current (60 Hertz) only.

- 1. Plug the electrical cord into a 120V AC electrical outlet.
- Push the ON/OFF button. The power indicator light will illuminate to signal that the heating pad is at Low setting. Press the settings buttons to choose among Low, Medium and High levels.
- 3. Choose your heat setting: LOW, MED, HIGH. Place heating pad on top of the area to be treated.
- 4. When treatment is done, press the ON/OFF button to turn unit off and unplug. For maximum benefit, use should not exceed 30 minutes at one time. **Note:** this unit has a 60-minute auto-off feature.
- Do not use or store heating pad in a folded position.Use and store lying flat.
